Code of Conduct

The expectations at Amor Dei Academy are that Students may not partake in the following:

1. Conduct that is violent. Some examples of violent conduct are but not limited to:

- o Threatning or hurting a student, parent or staff member
- o Damaging someone else's personal property or school property (Parents are responsible for any damage incurred by their student and must make necessary replacement/repair)

2. Conduct that is disorderly or encourage others to do the same. Examples of disorderly conduct are but not limited to:

- o Doing something that can be physically dangerous to one's own self or others
- o Disturbing the learning environment
- o Excessive rough play.

3. Conduct that puts other people's safety or health in danger. Some examples of this conduct are but not limited to:

- o Stealing property of students, teachers or anyone else on school property or school function
- o Bullying (including electronically), of any student, staff or parent
- o Having or sharing materials that are inappropriate (Including electronically)
- o Using foul language, cursing or swearing
- o Possessing any illegal substances, paraphernalia, or weapons at Amor Dei Academy or any school events

4. Conduct that refuses to obey authority. Some examples of this are but not limited to:

- o Not following the directions of the teachers or any other school administrators
- o Walking on/off campus without teacher permission or leaving the classroom at any time without teacher permission

5. Students must abide by the Amor Dei Academy Dress Code

- o No strapless/tube tops or see through clothing, clothing with inappropriate words or graphics on clothing or blatantly immodest clothing is prohibited
- o Any apparel which the administration determines to be unacceptable in light of Amor Dei Academy standards is prohibited. Students who violate the dress code policy will be asked to call a parent for a change of clothing.

Parent Responsibility:

Parents should help their child(ren) develop positive, Christ-centered relationships at Amor Dei Academy. If a serious or ongoing situation arises between students, parents should work together to help the children appropriately resolve their conflict(s). Amor Dei Academy reserves the right to promptly remove dangerous and chronically disruptive students from the learning environment.

2.0 Student Drop-off and Pick-up

When students are dropped off, parents may come to the front table; however, only Amor Dei Academy students and ADAC staff are allowed beyond the front drop-off/pick-up table. Student pick-up and hand-off activities will have the oversight of an ADAC Aide.

3.0 Waiver of Liability - ADAC

The waiver of liability in this section applies to all activities conducted at an ADAC facility. Parental waivers of liability forms will be gathered for each student regarding activities that occur on the Amor Dei Academy campus, or Amor Dei Academy activities that are off-campus with parental supervision. Parental or guardian signature of this waiver is a requirement for student attendance at Amor Dei Academy and must be signed by the parent or guardian for each student attending Amor Dei Academy prior to the first day of attendance at Amor Dei Academy.
